
CONNOISSEURS' GUIDE TO CALIFORNIA WINE

First, let us say that there is a good bit of attractive, currant-like fruit at the core of this wine and that sweet oak lends plenty of immediate appeal. There are, however, lots of gruff and grippy tannins to contend with as well, and the wine's deep flavors are presently overtaken with puckery dryness in the latter going. The point here is patience, and, if six or seven years of age are asked, the wine will do no other than shine when it finally reaches its best drinking form.
