

Darms Lane 2011 Pinot Noir Russian River Valley

Notes:

Known for its small production of estate grown Cabernet Sauvignon from the Napa Valley, Darms Lane Family is excited to release its second vintage of Pinot Noir from the Russian River Valley. Sourced from the Dutton Ranch, Barron Vineyard in the Green Valley, the grapes were destemmed and fermented in an open top tank using both punch downs and pumpovers to manage the extraction. After pressing, the wine was racked to barrel and the lees were stirred every two week during the first 3 months of barrel aging. The wine was then allowed to settle so it could be racked cleanly and bottled unfined and unfiltered the last week of August 2012.

Wine Description:

Our elegant 2011 Pinot Noir exhibits wild rasberry and cocoa aromas on the nose. Fruit forward and mouthwatering, the palate displays layers of dark berries, fresh porcini, black tea and nutmeg hints. This wine is full-bodied, complex with a persistent finish. Enjoy on its own or with roasted poultry, grilled salmon or beef stews.
